RE: BILLIE JEAN KING CUP BY GAINBRIDGE AFRICA GROUP III 2026.

Team Kenya Arrives in Gaborone as Billie Jean King Cup Campaign Begins.

Team Kenya Ladies team has safely arrived in Gaborone, Botswana, ahead of the Billie Jean King Cup by Gainbridge Africa Group III, which takes place from 13–18 July 2026.

The official draw was conducted on last night (Sunday 12/07/27), placing Kenya in Pool B alongside Tunisia, Algeria and Ghana. The four nations will compete in a round-robin format, with the top 2 teams progressing to the promotion play-offs as they battle for a place in Africa Group II.

The remaining teams, Pool A comprises hosts Botswana, Zimbabwe and Burundi, while Pool C features Nigeria, Madagascar, Namibia and Cameroon.

About the Event.

The Billie Jean King Cup is the Women's Tennis World Cup event. Nations compete against one another in a team format.

The Africa Group III competition, taking place in Gaborone, Botswana from 13–18 July 2026, brings together 11 African nations competing for the opportunity to earn promotion to Africa Group II. Teams are drawn into pools, where they play round-robin ties before progressing to the promotion play-offs.

This year's Africa Group III event features 11 African nations competing for promotion to Africa Group II. The participating countries are:
