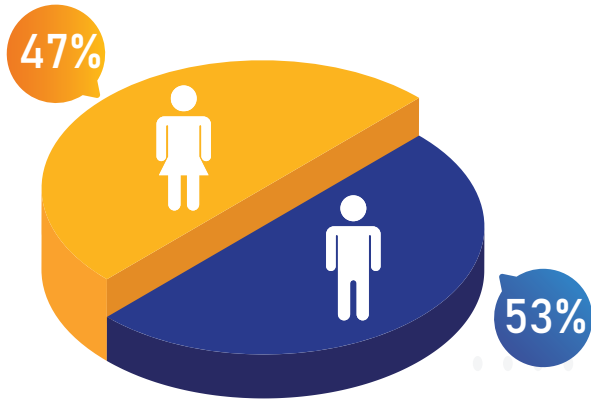

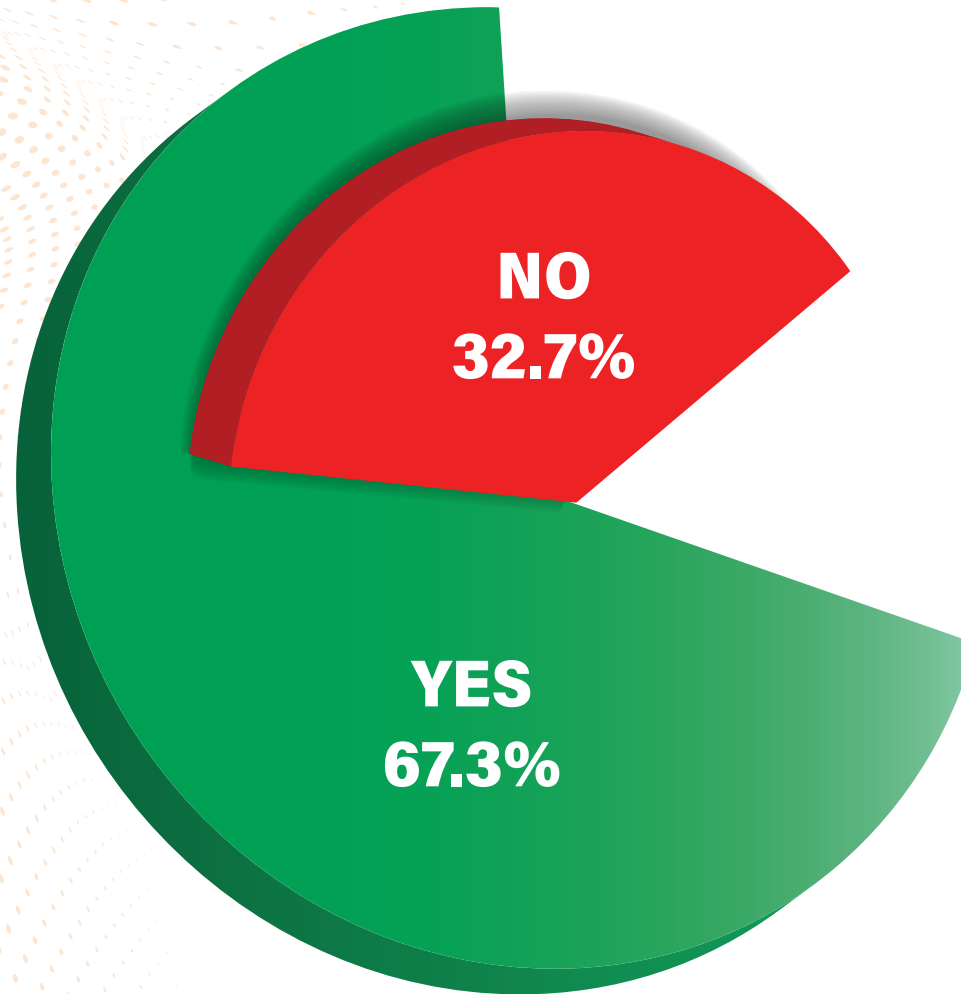

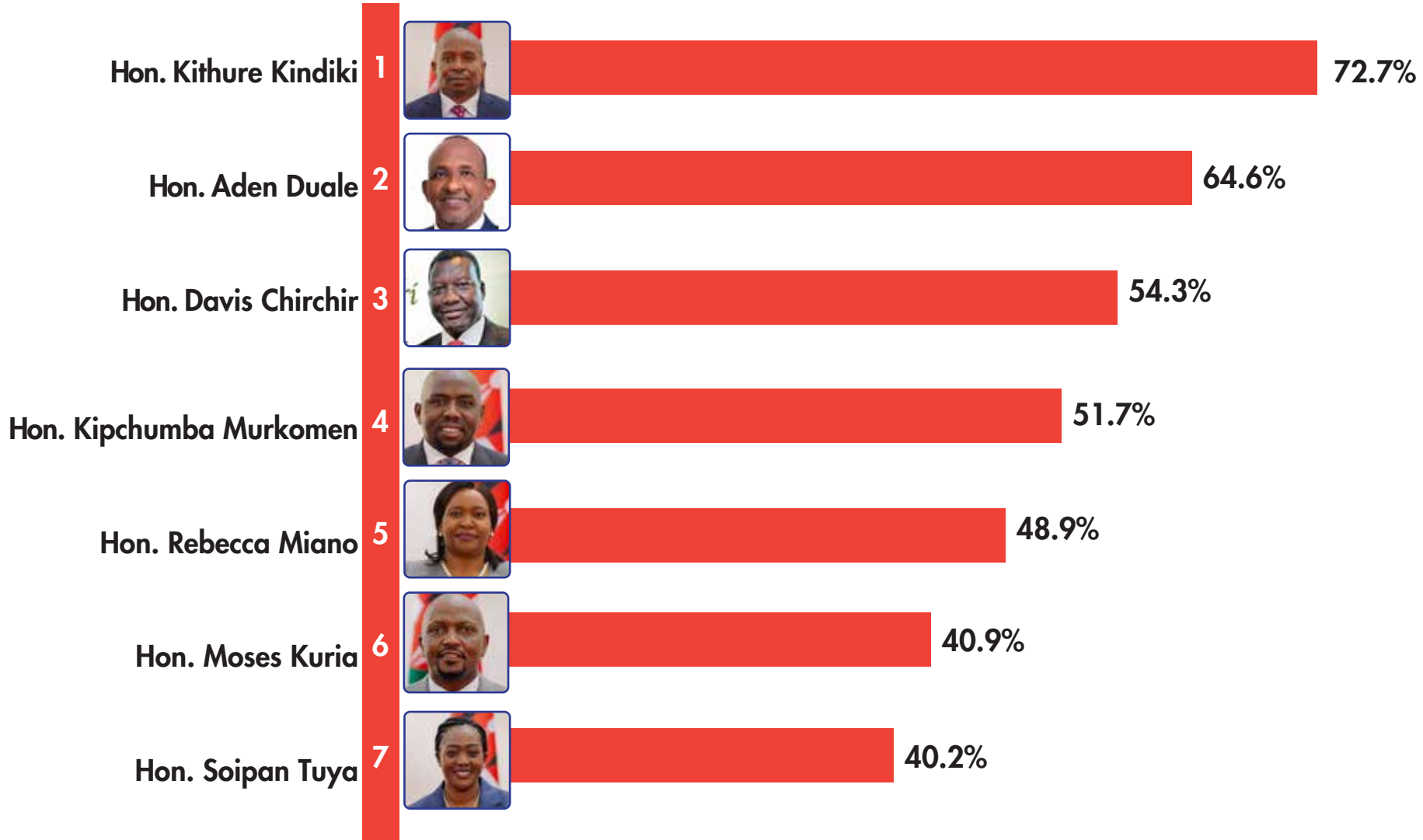

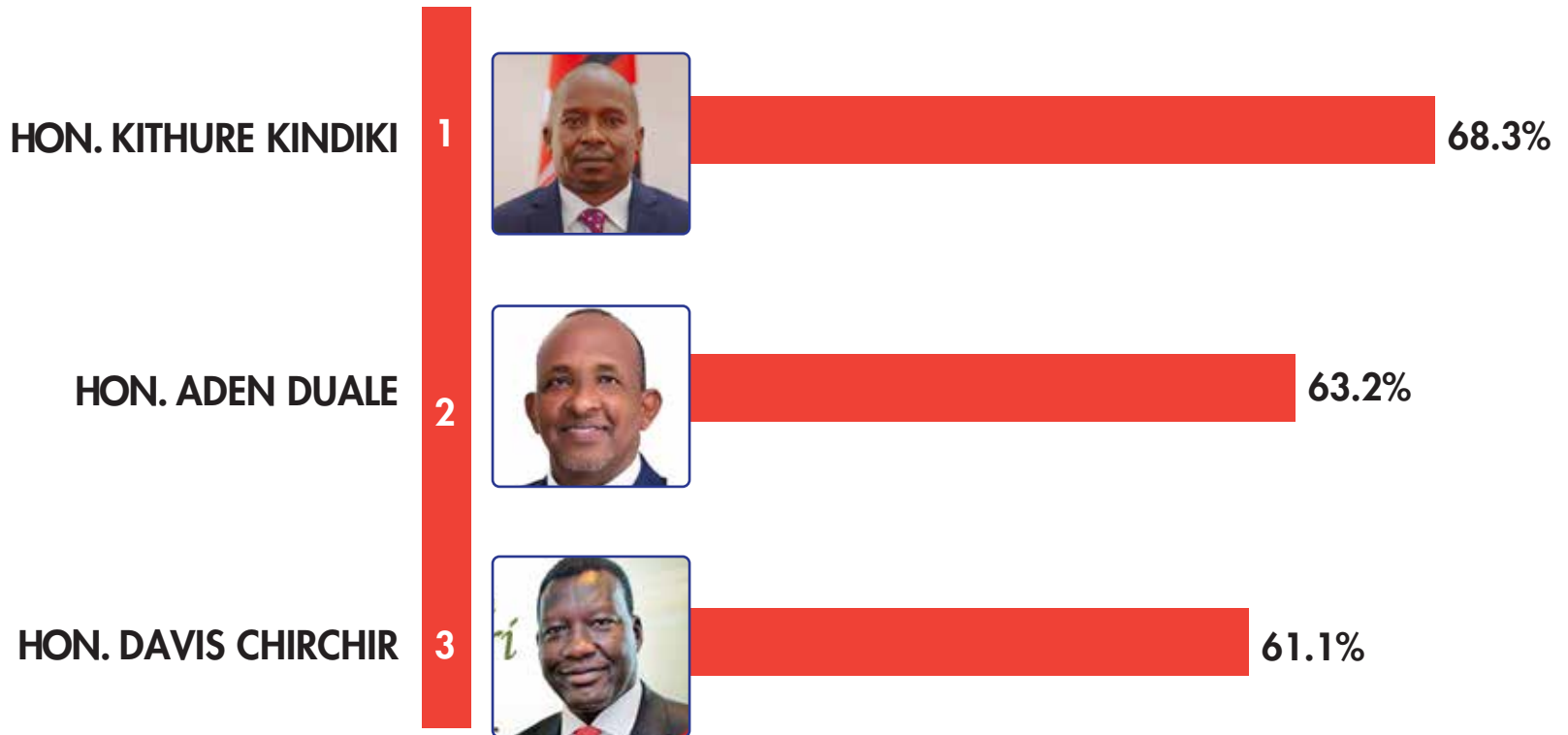

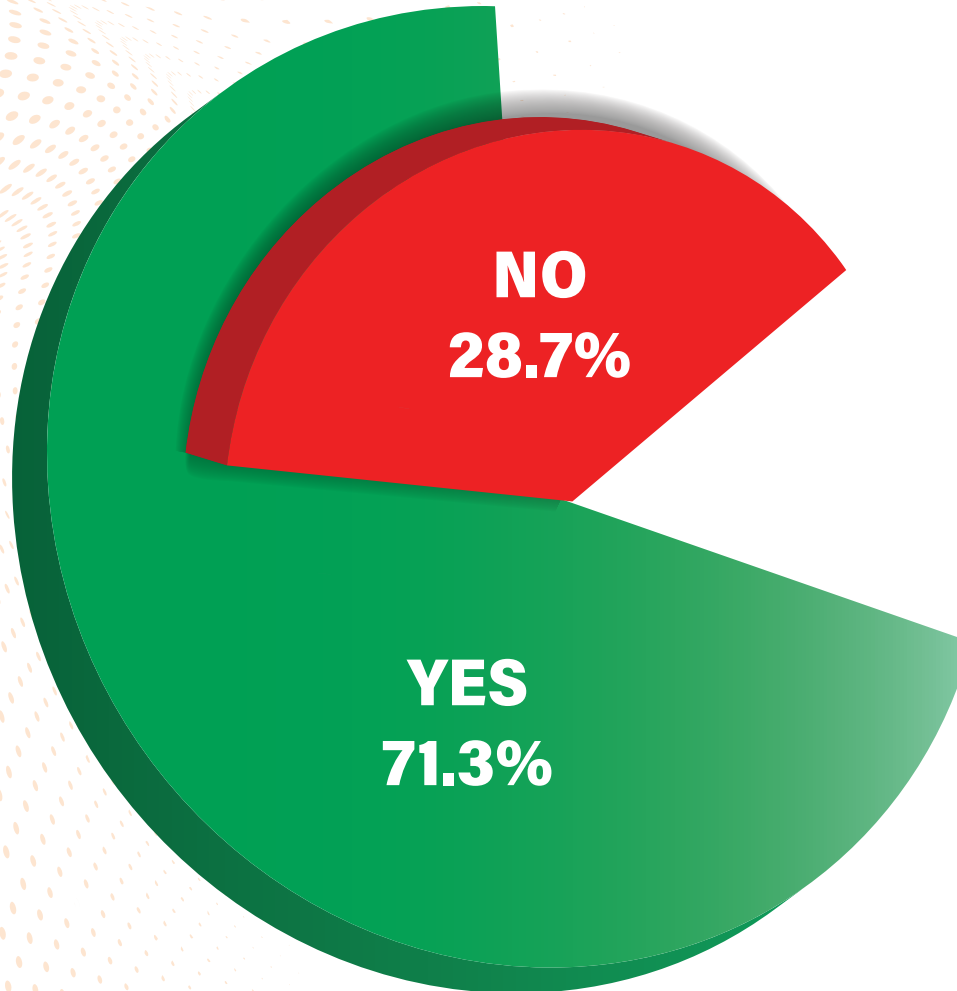

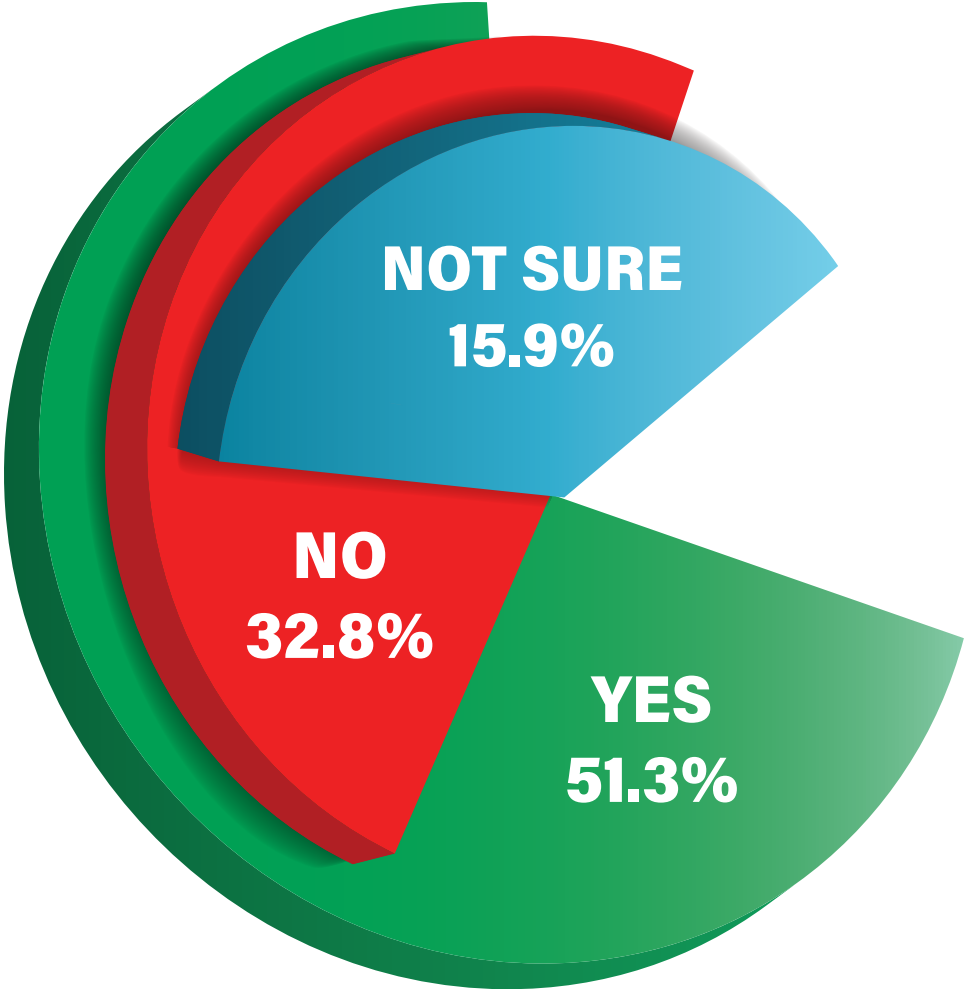

Politrack Africa Poll Reveals

Kenyans' Views On Cabinet Dissolution (Nairobi, Kenya - 17th July, 2024)

Politrack Africa, a leading polling firm, has released the results of its latest nationwide survey, offering insights into Kenyan public opinion following the recent disbanding of the cabinet by the Head of State.

The poll, conducted from July 12 -15 , 2024, surveyed 6,064 registered voters across all 47 counties in Kenya using computer assisted telephonic interviews.

The primary focus of the study was to assess the impact of the cabinet disbandment amidst widespread anti-government protests across the nation. Respondents were questioned on whether this move had bolstered confidence in the government among the disgruntled electorate. Additionally, the survey sought insights into the preferred composition of a new cabinet and public sentiment towards reinstating ejected Cabinet secretaries.

Key findings from the poll indicate that 67% of Kenyans applaud the dissolution of cabinet while 32% were not satisfied by the executive move. The executive order to end the Cabinet Secretaries tenure further inspired confidence in the president as expressed by 51.3% of respondents with a public discontent being expressed by a significant 32.8% calling for more reforms. Among such reforms included a desire to see the size of the cabinet reduced to 15 members, by a substantial 71.3% of respondents citing efficiency and cost-effectiveness as primary reasons. This sentiment underscores a widespread belief among Kenyans that a leaner cabinet could lead to better governance and accountability.

Furthermore, the survey revealed mixed reactions regarding the reinstatement of former Cabinet secretaries. While some respondents advocated for specific individuals to return based on their perceived competence or alignment with public interests, others favored entirely new faces to refresh leadership and address ongoing challenges facing the nation.

The survey revealed a strong desire for a smaller cabinet, which many Kenyans believe could lead to better governance and accountability. This sentiment was particularly pronounced, with some participants expressing forceful opinions on the matter. These findings provide crucial insights into Kenyan public views on governance at a critical juncture. The poll's results suggest a significant appetite for change in the structure and composition of the government.
